Program Information

Application Procedure	Students who are nominated for OSUN mobility are accepted to Bard College.
Acceptance to Bard	Upon acceptance to OSUN Mobility, Bard will issue an acceptance letter or letter of
	invitation. For graduate students, acceptance is determined by the respective
	graduate department / institution.
Orientation Meeting	Accepted students committed to attending Bard must participate in a Zoom
	orientation.
Course Enrollment	Students should complete the OSUN Student Mobility Learning Agreement and have
	approval from their home institution for their planned courses.
Course Registration	Undergraduate students register for their courses online. Registration for graduate
	students is facilitated by the specific graduate department.
Registration Dates	Online registration typically occurs in early December for spring semesters and early
	May for fall semesters.
Course Eligibility	Students can choose from most of the courses offered as long as prerequisites are
	fulfilled where applicable and space is available. OSUN exchange students are not
	eligible to take language intensive courses.
Semester Dates	Fall Semester: August – December
	Spring Semester: January – May
Undergraduate Course Load	Students should follow the minimum requirement for full-time status according to
	their home university and should not take less than 12 credits to maintain immigration
	status. Students cannot exceed 20 credits per semester.
Graduate Course Load	Students should follow the minimum requirement for full-time status according to
	their home university and should not take less than 9 credits to maintain immigration
	status. The maximum allowable credits per semester depends upon the program.

Registration Instructions	Prior to online registration, undergraduate students are urged to contact Bard faculty for their desired courses to introduce themselves and request permission to a particular course. Graduate students will be registered in coordination with the program they plan to attend.
Method of Instruction	The class format is based on lectures, readings, class participation and self-study. Students are expected to attend all lectures, to complete all course-related assignments and readings, and to sit exams and/or submit a final paper in order to receive a course grade.
Credits	Bard uses U.S. academic credits. Most classes are 4 semester hours of academic credit. The average semester course load is 16 credits.

Housing	OSUN Exchange students are required to live on campus and will complete a housing	
	form after acceptance to the program. Requests for single room accommodations	
	may be accepted but are not guaranteed.	
Student Orientation	Bard College has a mandatory orientation for OSUN Exchange Students and other visiting and exchange students over the three days before classes begin.	
Airport Transport	Bard College will arrange group transportation from the airport for students who arrive within a designated time period to the appropriate airport. Instructions for planning flights and coordinating arrivals will be emailed to students ahead of time. Arrivals outside of the designated time frame will require coordination with Bard staff and may be a student's responsibility depending on the circumstances.	
Public Transportation	Bard College has its own shuttle that brings students to the surrounding towns and there is a Dutchess County bus that is free for all students with a Bard ID.	
Health Insurance	Students participating in an OSUN exchange will be enrolled in ISO International Student Health Insurance.	
Disability Accommodation	Students register their disability accommodation with Bard College as applicable prior to arrival.
