Application Procedure	Application deadline: Fall semester: 1 June Spring semester: 1 December
Institution Application Requirements	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Learning agreement; -Language Certificate Nominated students must have a B1 Level in English and/or Russian. Students will need to provide official language certificates of Level B1 for English. Official language certificates such as IELTS, IGCSE, and TOEFL are accepted. Certificates from the home university or its Language Centre can also be accepted; -Transcript of records from home university; -Application form; -Copy of your ID card or passport.
Acceptance to EHU	Fall semester: 1 July Spring semester: first week of January
Orientation Meeting	The first week of each semester. Pre-arrival online meeting with Buddy students takes place in September (fall semester) and February (Spring semester).
Course Enrollment	Students are enrolled in courses according to the LA.
Course Registration	The mobility manager registers students for selected courses before the start of each semester.
Registration Dates	First day of each semester.
Course Eligibility	Students can choose courses from all academic programs. Note: timetables are made to not overlap in one program, therefore if a student chooses courses from different programs, they may overlap in the timetables and students may need to repick other courses in the beginning of semester.
Semester Dates	Fall semester: October 1-February 28

Student Orientation	<p>We strongly recommend for new international students to participate in the Introductory Week organized before beginning of Autumn and Spring Semester. During this week, students are acquainted with the University, student life and services for students, with Vilnius and wider area, offered to join trips.</p>
Airport Transport	<p>There is one international airport in Vilnius, which is the main international airport of the country.</p> <p>Vilnius Airport (Rodūnios kl. 10A, Vilnius) is 7 kilometers from the city centre.</p> <p>HOW TO REACH THE CITY CENTER FROM VILNIUS INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT?</p> <p>Public Transportation Bus 3G takes passengers to Žalasis Tiltas from the Airport and back. The first bus leaves from the airport each morning at 05:00, and the last one at 23:00.</p> <p>PLEASE NOTE! A special ticket must be purchased for bus 3G for 0.90 EUR – ticket valid for one trip. You can buy this ticket at the bus driver on the bus (please keep in mind, the bus driver only takes EUR in cash, no debit card, or other currency). Also you can buy a special plastic card "Vilniečio kortelė"</p>

Cost of Living	Students typically spend 150-180 EUR per month on food. The price of a meal at a cafe in the city center ranges from 6 to 15 EUR.
Monthly Transportation Ticket	<p>Full-time students are subject to a 50% discount on short-term, paper tickets purchased from the driver.</p> <p>For full-time students, there is a 50% discount for short-term (30 min, 60 min) tickets. For full-time students, there is an 80% discount for long-term tickets (1 day, 3 days, 5 days, 10 days, 30 days, 90 days, 180 days, 270 days, and 365 days).</p> <p>Monthly Transportation Ticket: 5,80 Eur.</p>
Health Insurance	<p>Health Insurance is one of the obligatory requirements for all international students at European Humanities University (EHU) that must be organized before students' arrival.</p> <p>OSUN Undergraduate students will be enrolled in GeoBlue health insurance. There are two types of Health Insurance recognized in Lithuanian health care institutions:</p> <p>European Health Insurance Card (available for citizens of EU/ EEA countries)</p> <p>Private health insurance</p> <p>The insurance must be valid throughout the entire study period and cover any expenses which might arise in connection with repatriation for medical reasons, urgency medical attention, emergency hospital treatment or death during the stay. The minimum coverage of the private insurance must be not less than 30.000,00 EUR.</p> <p>Note! The documents must be original and written in English language.</p> <p>International students who need to extend their health insurance while being in Lithuania, can address one of these companies:</p> <p>ERGO Lietuvos draudimas Gjensidige</p>

VISA Information

VISA	<p>Students who are citizens of any country in the EU, EEA, EFTA do not need a visa to enter the Republic of Lithuania. Those students whose exchange (mobility) period is longer than 3 months will have to apply for the Certificate (of the form established by the Minister of the Interior) signifying their right to temporarily reside in Lithuania at the local migration office.</p> <p>For all other exchange students and free-movers (non-EU countries citizens) a National Visa (D-type) is compulsory.</p> <p>Students from countries who's citizens do not require visas for entrance to the Republic of Lithuania (Do I need a visa?) can arrive to Lithuania freely, BUT after the arrival such students will have to apply for National Visa (D-type) at the local Migration Office in Vilnius (Vytenio str. 18, Vilnius).</p> <p>Students from countries who's citizens require visas for entrance to the Republic of Lithuania must apply for National Visa (D-type) beforehand at the closest diplomatic missions or consular offices of the Republic of Lithuania.</p> <p>In order to get a National Visa (D-type), the Exchange Student or free-mover must submit the following: (https://www.migracija.lt/esu-studentasSection: "I want to come according to the student exchange programme. What should I do?"):</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Intermediation Letter number (from EHU); 2. Valid travel document (Passport) (its validity must be no less than 1 more year longer after the last day of stay in Lithuania); 3. Completed form of application for National D type Visa (Electronic application form must be completed according to instruction provided in the form); 4. One photo of 35x45 mm, corresponding to the age of the Student; 5. Receipt of the paid consular fee (exchange programmes participants from certain countries may be exempted);

Document certifying his/her health insurance coverage (valid in all Schengen countries till the expiration date of requested visa) for at least 30000 Eur* (in Lithuanian, English or Russian);</p> <p>7. Document certifying his/her sufficient subsistence means (365 Eur per month + 730 Eur for travel expenses);</p> <p>Additional documents can be requested.</p> <p>Registration for VISA D application (if you apply in Lithuania).</p> <p>Students with National D-type visas can reside in Lithuania for up to 12 months and can travel to other Schengen countries (for up to 90 days in total). If the period of stay in Lithuania is longer, all international students will be required to apply for a Temporary Residence Permit.</p>
Nationalities Not Requiring a Tourist Visa, Staying less than 180 days	Students, who are EU citizens, do not need a visa to enter Lithuania. Only a valid ID card or passport is required. If you are staying in the country longer than for 3 months, you have to apply to the <u>Migration Office</u> and local authority called Seniūnija for a <u>certificate</u> confirming the right of EU Member State citizen to permanently reside in the Republic of Lithuania.
Nationalities requiring a tourist visa, Staying less than 180 days	Non-European students, before their arrival to Lithuania, must receive a National D-type visa. Visa is valid for up to 12 months.
Exchange students staying for more than 180 days	
Residence Permit	If the period in Lithuania is longer, an international student is required to receive a permanent residence permit.
