Acceptance to NSYSU	The application result will be emailed 2-4 weeks after the application period ends.
Orientation Meeting	Accepted students committed to attending NSYSU must participate in OSUN Zoom orientation.
Course Enrollment	Students should complete the OSUN Student Mobility Learning Agreement and have approval from their home institution for their planned courses.
Course Registration	Register online and/or on paper forms.
Registration Dates	Preliminary Selection (II) - Online: 1 week before the semester starts.
	Add&Drop(I)&(II)- Online: 1st and 2nd week of classes
	Exceptional Circumstances (paperwork): 3 rd week of classes
	Withdrawal (paperwork): 1 month before the final examination week

Course Eligibility	Students can choose from most of the courses offered as long as prerequisites are fulfilled where applicable and space is available.
Semester Dates	Fall Semester: September – January. Spring Semester: February - June
Undergraduate and Graduate Course Load	Students should take credits between 3-25 per semester at NSYSU.

Registration Instructions	Instructions will be sent by email 2 weeks prior to the first registration period.
Method of Instruction	The class format is based on lectures, readings, class participation, and self-study. Students are expected to attend all lectures, complete all course-related assignments and readings, sit exams and/or submit a final paper in order to receive a course grade.
Credits	1 credit at NSYSU is equal to 1 course hour per week. There are 16-18 weeks in one semester. Most regular courses are 3-credit courses, which means 3 course hours per session per week.
