Course Eligibility	Students can choose from most of the courses offered as long as prerequisites are

Semester Dates	Fall Semester: August – December

Undergraduate Course Load	Students should follow the minimum requirement for full-time status according to			
	their home university and should not exceed 20 credits per semester.			

Graduate Course Load	Students should follow the minimum requirement for full-time status according to their home university and should not exceed 18 credits per semester.

Student Orientation	Universidad de los Andes has an orientation session over three days on the Wednesday, Thursday and Friday before classes begin. OSUN Mobility Exchange are required to attend.	
Airport Transport	UniAndes can arrange a taxi pick up from the airport paid for by the student.	
Cost of Living	Estimated between \$650 - \$1000 per month depending upon living situation.	
Monthly Transportation Ticket	\$40.00	
Health Insurance	Students participating in an OSUN exchange must have an international travel and health insurance. OSUN will purchase GeoBlue health insurance for incoming students at UniAndes.	
Disability Accommodation	UniAndes reviews each case individually to confirm whether the institution is able to provide the services according to the needs.

Residence Permit	Students are required to obtain a residence permit (cédula de extranjería) once they arrive in Bogota if they have a student visa. This procedure must be done within the next 15 days of his arrival to Colombia, and costs approximately \$90 US Dollars.
