Program Information

Language of Instruction	Language of instruction is English and students should submit a C1 language certificate with their OSUN application. German as a foreign language courses are available.
Application Procedure	Once you have completed the OSUN Student Mobility application and have been nominated for an OSUN Mobility exchange semester, you are accepted to Bard College Berlin.
Acceptance to BCB	Upon acceptance, Bard College will issue an acceptance letter.
Orientation Meeting	Accepted student committed to attending BCB must participate in in-person orientation prior to the start of the semester.
Course Enrollment	Students should complete the OSUN Student Mobility Learning Agreement and have approval from their home institution for their planned courses.
Course Registration	Students register their courses online
Registration Dates	Registration is over one week each semester; notification will be provided ahead of time via students' BCB email address.
Course Eligibility	Students can choose from most of the courses offered except for Foundation Level courses, as long as prerequisites are fulfilled where applicable.
Semester Dates	Fall Semester: August/September – December Spring Semester: January – May
Course Load	Students should follow the minimum requirement for full-time status according to their home university and should not exceed 40 ECTS credits per semester.
Internships	Students have the opportunity to participate in an internship for credit. Students engage in an internship for 10 – 13 hours per week while attending an accompanying Internship Seminar course. After acceptance, students apply to the internship program as indicated in the acceptance communication from BCB. Registration Instructions	Registration for courses is completed online via a google form. Students list
	their first four choices for courses followed by three alternates. In choosing
	courses, students should be sure to avoid conflicting course times.

Airport Transport	Student guides can pick students up at the airport provided they arrive at
	Berlin Brandenburg Airport between 9 am – 4 pm on the Wednesday before
	courses begin. Please provide arrival information via the arrivals form sent
	in advance of arrivals.
Monthly Transportation Ticket	BCB provides an unlimited pass for the entire Berlin city transportation
and Reader Fee	system called a Semesterticket as well as student readers (textbooks).
	Students must transfer the appropriate fee to BCB Student Accounts prior to
	arrival if it is not covered by the OSUN scholarship.
Health Insurance	Students acquire Geoblue through OSUN.
Disability Accommodation	Any student that requires a disability accommodation should register their
