Application Procedure	Students who are nominated for OSUN mobility are accepted to Bard College

Acceptance to Bard College at	Upon acceptance to OSUN Mobility, Bard College Simon's Rock will issue an
Simon's Rock	acceptance letter or letter of invitation.
Orientation Meeting	Accepted students committed to attending Bard College at Simon's Rock must
	participate in a Zoom orientation prior to arrival and an on-campus
	orientation.
Course Enrollment	Students should complete the OSUN Student Mobility Learning Agreement
	and have approval from their home institution for their planned courses.
Course Registration	Students register for their courses through the office of Academic Affairs
	(acaffairs@simons-rock.edu).
Registration Dates	Online registration typically occurs in early December for spring semesters
	and early May for fall semesters.
Course Eligibility	Students can choose from most of the courses offered pending enrollment
	availability and as long as the stated prerequisites have been fulfilled.
Semester Dates	Fall Semester: August – December
	Spring Semester: January – May
Undergraduate Course Load	Students should follow the minimum requirement for full-time status
	according to their home university and should not take less than 12 credits to

	maintain immigration status. Students cannot exceed 18 credits per
	semester.

Method of Instruction	The class format at Bard College at Simon's Rock is based on lectures,
	readings, class participation and self-study. Students are expected to attend
	all lectures, to complete all course-related assignments and readings, and to
	take exams and/or submit a final paper in order to receive a course grade.
Credits	Bard College at Simon's Rock uses U.S. academic credits. Most classes earn
	between 3-4 semester hours of academic credit. The average semester
	course load is 16 credits.

Housing	OSUN Exchange students are required to live on campus.
Student Orientation	Bard College at Simon's Rock has a mandatory orientation for OSUN
	Exchange Students. In addition, each semester, students who are new to
	the campus participate in an on-campus orientation before classes begin.
Airport Transport	Bard College at Simon's Rock arranges group transportation from the airport for students who arrive at selected airports on the day scheduled for airport pickup. Instructions for planning flights and coordinating arrivals can be requested via transportation@simons-rock.edu. Arrivals outside of the designated time frame will require coordination with BCSR staff and may be the student's responsibility.
Public Transportation	Bard College at Simon's Rock runs a shuttle that provides transportation on
	campus.
Health Insurance	Students participating in an OSUN exchange will be enrolled in ISO
	International Student Health Insurance.
