**Program Information**

<b>Application Procedure</b>	Students will complete an online application.
<b>Institution Application Requirements</b>	Students must meet the following minimum requirements of Test of English as Foreign Language (TOEFL): Internet-based - Score: 62 or Paper-based - Score: 500 Tuskegee also accepts tests from the English Language Testing System (IELTS). Score of 5.0 or higher
<b>Acceptance to Tuskegee</b>	Students will receive an official letter of acceptance.
<b>Orientation Meeting</b>	Upon arrival with immigration coordinator- Ms. Joan Wynn
<b>Course Enrollment</b>	Min of 12 hours face-to-face
<b>Course Registration</b>	Submit requested classes that must be approved by academic advisor upon review of transcript.
<b>Registration Dates</b>	Upon acceptance
<b>Course Eligibility</b>	Per transcript and department approval
<b>Semester Dates</b>	Mid Aug –early Dec, early Jan – early May
<b>Undergraduate Course Load</b>	15 hours
<b>Graduate Course Load</b>	9 hours
<b>Method of Instruction</b>	Face-to-face
<b>Academic Coordinators For Semester Exchange Students</b>	Dr. Rhonda Collier
