≡ COURSE DESCRIPTION

This class is conceived as a means, for the students, to progress, and as a help in their daily life in France as well.

≡ COURSE OBJECTIVES

B1/B2 levels corresponds to a true level of intermediate (Threshold) to upper-intermediate (Vantage).

Objectives: at the end of the course: the student:

- Can understand the main points of clear standard input on familiar matters regularly encountered in work, school, leisure, etc.
- Can deal with most situations likely to arise while travelling in an area where the language is spoken.
- Can produce simple connected text on topics that are familiar or of personal interest.
- Can describe experiences and events, dreams, hopes and ambitions and briefly give reasons and explanations for opinions and plans.
